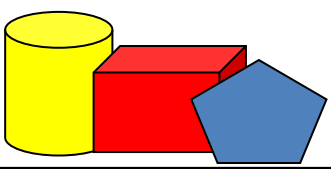

Fractions: numerator, denominator

Shape: angle, symmetry, vertex, edge

Money: change, pence, pounds, decimal

Statistics: data, bar chart, pictogram

Art and Design & Technology Key Vocabulary:

Sculpture, sculptor, armature, modelling, twist, manipulate, bend, hollow, design, craft, evaluation.

Annotated diagram, final design, function, plan, friction, technique, compare, evaluate, sketch, mechanisms, smooth, exploded diagram, design, prototype.

Science Key Vocabulary:
