

# Dropping off and picking up:

- All children will enter at the same time through the main blue gates and line up in their allocated space on the playground for the first 3 days to help with the transition and to give parents and teachers a chance to get to know each other. Class teachers will hold a class sign up to support this and the diagram below shows where each class will line up. When your child is in their class line, we ask that you move away from the line to allow space for the rest of the class to line up. Parents can wait in the playground until their child's class has gone in if they wish but must leave immediately after.
- From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September, independent walking in will be in operation. Parents can still walk their children through the gates, but we do not expect the children to line up, they go in through the allocated doors closest to where they had lined up. Senior Leadership & Pupil Welfare staff will be in the playground to assist with this.
- At the end of the school day, the main blue gates will be opened for parents; teachers and TAs will bring the children out and line up in the same allocated space and release their class one by one (anyone collecting must be over the age of 14 and on the child's emergency contact list). Please ensure you allow space for all the classes to line up.

### **Uniform and PE kits:**

Owing to similarities in clothing, parents are advised to mark <u>all</u> clothing with their child's name. **Hooded tops**are not to be worn inside the school premises, they are for outdoor wear only.

Friday	Sycamore, Beech*, Sweet Gum *Year 4 will also have swimming tuition (on a Friday in the Autumn term), starting with Beech Class (Miss Alter) 12th September 2025 for 10 weeks, Miss Alter will confirm the other classes in the Autumn term ready for Spring term.

### Other useful information:

**Open Mornings:** We will be holding open mornings and welcome parents and carers to come in and meet staff, listen to a presentation, and ask any questions they may have. Year 6 – Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September, Year 5- Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> September, Year 4- Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September, Year 3- Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September. Cherry Class will hold a Learning Together afternoon within the first few weeks once we have fully settled the children, date TBC.

**Medication**: Please ensure any required medication is brought into school on 3<sup>rd</sup> September e.g. asthma pumps. If your child has had any medical updates over the summer (e.g. medication changes) please ensure you call the office and get advice.

**Water bottle and fountains:** Ensure your child has a reusable water bottle in school each day. Water fountains will only be in use to refill their bottles.

**Equipment: The school will provide all the equipment children need in school** so they should not bring in their own equipment and pencil cases in with them. Also, they should not be bringing 'fidget' toys into school.

## **Free School Meals:**

As you will be aware for the academic year 2025-2026 your child will receive their free school meals automatically, but it's vitally important that you still complete our school or borough's registration form in case your child is eligible for extra funding for their school from the Government, worth £1,300 per year.

This is extra money to spend on enrichment activities, teacher development, and targeted support for the children that need it most. It may also entitle you to other benefits like food vouchers during the holidays.
